OVERVIEW OF CAMP

World Breastfeeding Week 2026 was celebrated by Br. Nath Pai College of Nursing, Kudal from 01 Aug 2026 to 07 Aug 2026. The theme for the World Breastfeeding Week is "Breastfeeding for a sustainable start in life: strengthen what works," focuses on tracking progress, evaluating impact, and scaling proven approaches that improve breastfeeding outcomes. It calls on governments, health systems, workplaces, communities, civil society organizations, and families to build on successful experiences and strengthen the "Warm Chain of Support" for breastfeeding.

OBJECTIVES -

World Breastfeeding Week (celebrated August 1–7) aims to protect, promote, and support breastfeeding. Core objectives include raising awareness of health benefits, building supportive workplace and community environments, strengthening healthcare systems, and encouraging protective government policies for nursing mothers worldwide

Raise Awareness: Inform the public about the short- and long-term health, nutritional, and economic benefits of breastfeeding for both infants and mothers.

Promote Exclusive Feeding: Encourage exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months of life, followed by continued breastfeeding alongside safe complementary foods.

Build Support Systems: Establish helpful networks across families, communities, and workplaces to make nursing practical and sustainable.

Strengthen Policies: Push for robust government laws, paid maternity leave, and workplace lactation accommodations.

Train Health Workers: Equip medical staff and peer counselors with the skills needed to guide and troubleshoot feeding challenges for new mothers.

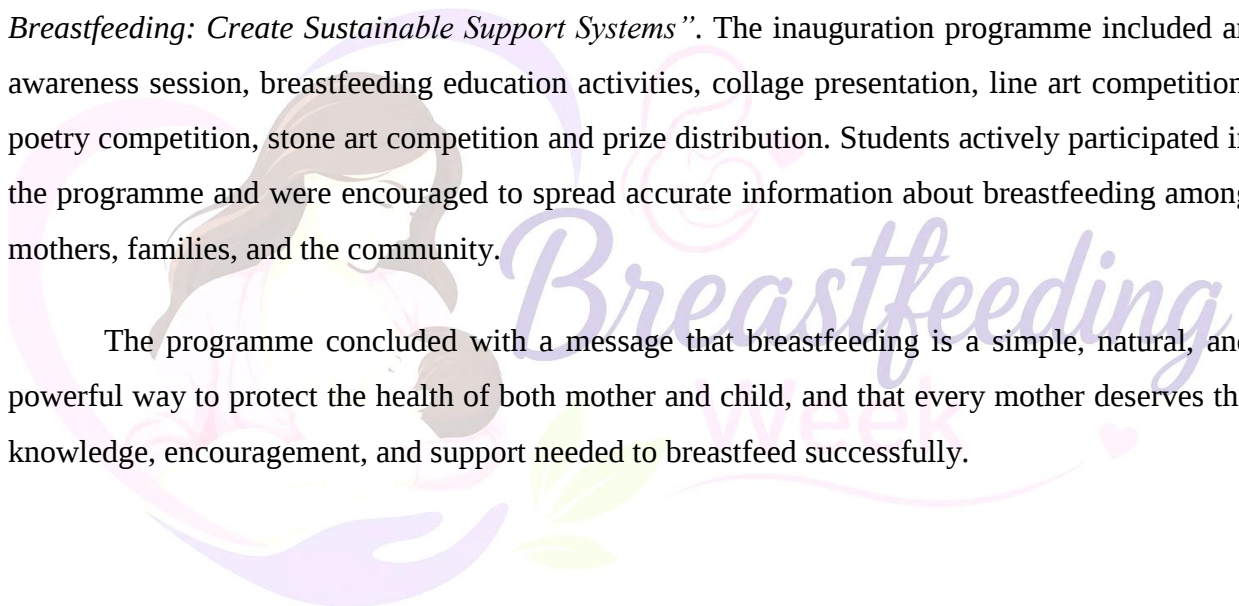

THE OPENING CEREMONY

World Breastfeeding Week 2026 was inaugurated at **Br. Nath Pai College of Nursing, Kudal**, with the aim of creating awareness about the importance of breastfeeding for the health and well-being of mothers and infants. The programme emphasized the importance of early initiation of breastfeeding, exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months, and continued breastfeeding along with complementary feeding thereafter. The role of healthcare professionals, particularly nurses, in providing appropriate breastfeeding education, counselling, and support to mothers was also highlighted.

The Theme for this year's world breastfeeding week 2026 entitled as "*Prioritize Breastfeeding: Create Sustainable Support Systems*". The inauguration programme included an awareness session, breastfeeding education activities, collage presentation, line art competition, poetry competition, stone art competition and prize distribution. Students actively participated in the programme and were encouraged to spread accurate information about breastfeeding among mothers, families, and the community.

The programme concluded with a message that breastfeeding is a simple, natural, and powerful way to protect the health of both mother and child, and that every mother deserves the knowledge, encouragement, and support needed to breastfeed successfully.

Health Checkup Camp (ANC and PNC Mothers)

Target Group: Antenatal (ANC) and Postnatal (PNC) Mothers

Number of Beneficiaries: 10

A health check-up camp was organized for Antenatal (ANC) and Postnatal (PNC) mothers with the objective of providing comprehensive maternal health services and promoting healthy pregnancy, safe delivery, and proper postnatal care. The camp focused on early identification of maternal health problems, assessment of nutritional status, health education, and appropriate referral services.

Objectives

1. To assess the health status of ANC and PNC mothers.
2. To identify pregnancy-related and postnatal complications at an early stage.
3. To monitor vital signs and other important health parameters.
4. To assess nutritional status and provide dietary advice.
5. To provide health education regarding antenatal and postnatal care.
6. To educate mothers regarding breastfeeding, immunization, and newborn care.
7. To advise mothers regarding danger signs and the need for timely medical care.
8. To provide appropriate referral and follow-up services when required.

The following services were provided during the camp:

- Registration and collection of basic demographic information.
- General health assessment.
- Measurement of blood pressure, pulse, respiratory rate and temperature, weight and assessment of nutritional status.
- Antenatal examination as indicated.
- Assessment of postnatal recovery and maternal well-being.
- Screening for common maternal health problems such as anemia, hypertension and other complications.
- Counselling regarding a balanced and nutritious diet, iron-folic acid and calcium supplementation as advised.
- Health education regarding personal hygiene and rest.
- Education on exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months.
- Guidance regarding breast care and prevention of breastfeeding problems.
- Counselling on newborn care and immunization.
- Education regarding family planning and appropriate contraceptive methods.
- Identification of mothers requiring further investigation or medical consultation.
- Referral of high-risk cases to the appropriate health facility.
- Distribution of sanitary pads.

Mothers were educated regarding:

For ANC Mothers:

- Importance of regular antenatal visits.
- Balanced diet and adequate rest.
- Iron, folic acid and calcium supplementation.
- Danger signs during pregnancy.
- Birth preparedness and complication readiness.
- Institutional delivery.
- Importance of tetanus/Td vaccination as advised.
- Importance of fetal movement monitoring.

For PNC Mothers:

- Postnatal hygiene and adequate rest.
- Nutritious diet and adequate fluid intake.
- Exclusive breastfeeding and correct breastfeeding technique.
- Maternal and newborn danger signs.
- Newborn immunization and routine follow-up.
- Family planning and birth spacing.
- Importance of postnatal follow-up visits.

The health check-up camp provided an opportunity for ANC and PNC mothers to receive basic health assessment, counseling, preventive services and appropriate referrals. Mothers were made aware of the importance of regular follow-up, proper nutrition, breastfeeding, newborn care and early recognition of danger signs. The Health Check-up Camp for ANC and PNC Mothers was successfully conducted with active participation of the mothers and nursing staff/students. The camp helped in promoting maternal and child health, identifying potential health problems at an early stage, and creating awareness regarding safe motherhood, breastfeeding, nutrition and newborn care.

Health Education at District Women & Children Hospital, Kudal

On the occasion of **World Breastfeeding Week 2026**, a health education programme was organized at District Women & Children Hospital, Kudal to create awareness among mothers and family members about the importance of breastfeeding for the health and development of infants.

Objectives

- To educate mothers about the importance of breastfeeding.
- To promote early initiation of breastfeeding within one hour of birth.
- To explain the benefits of exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months.
- To educate mothers regarding correct breastfeeding techniques and positioning.
- To clear common myths and misconceptions related to breastfeeding.
- To encourage continued breastfeeding along with complementary feeding after six months.

Health education was provided to antenatal and postnatal mothers regarding:

- Importance and benefits of breast milk.
- Colostrum and its nutritional and immunological benefits.
- Exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months.
- Correct positioning and attachment during breastfeeding.
- Breastfeeding on demand and maintaining adequate feeding frequency.
- Common breastfeeding problems and their prevention.
- Importance of complementary feeding after six months.
- Role of family members in supporting breastfeeding mothers.

The programme was attended by mothers, antenatal and postnatal women, family members, nursing students, and hospital staff. Nursing students actively participated in delivering health education and demonstrations. Interactive discussion and question-answer sessions were conducted to clarify the doubts of mothers and family members. The programme successfully increased awareness among mothers regarding appropriate breastfeeding practices. Participants understood the importance of colostrum, exclusive breastfeeding, proper attachment and positioning, and continued breastfeeding with complementary feeding after six months.

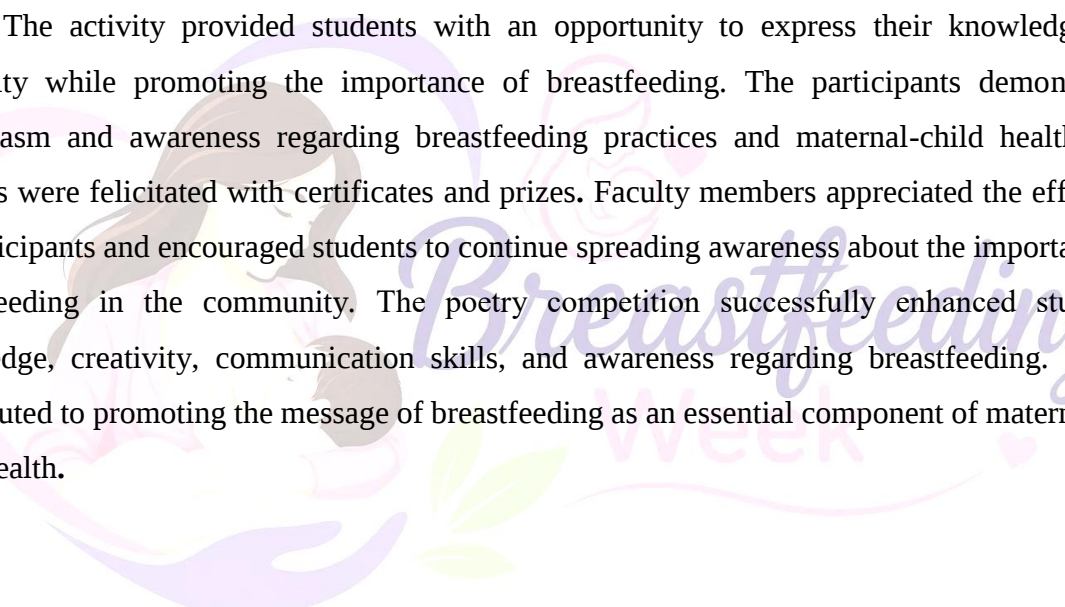

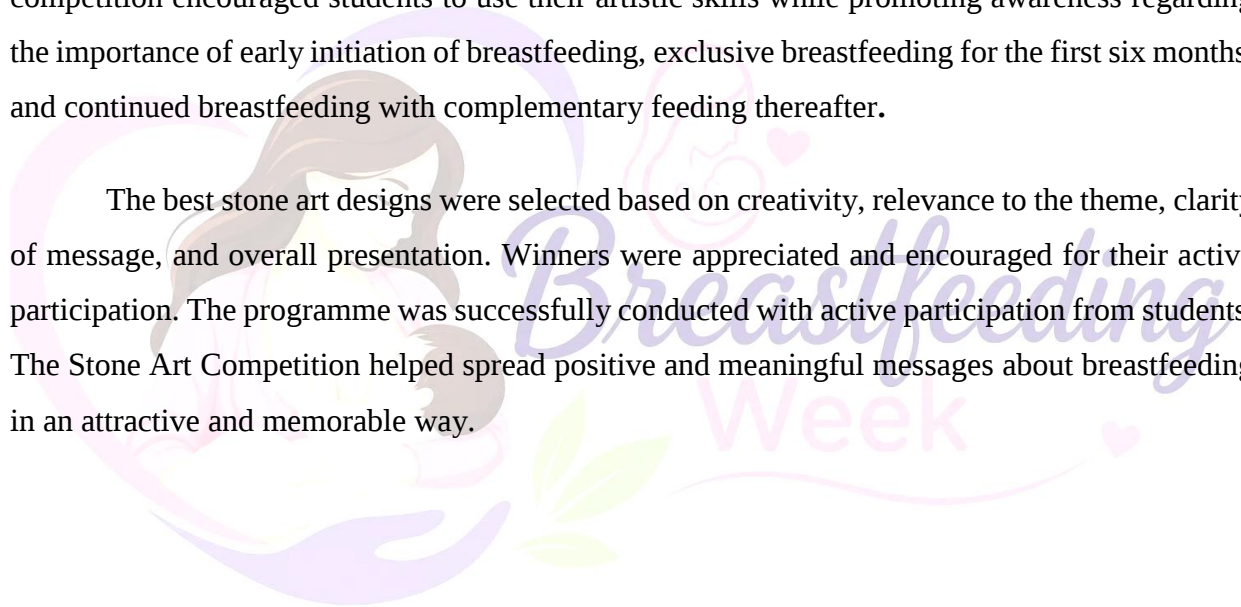

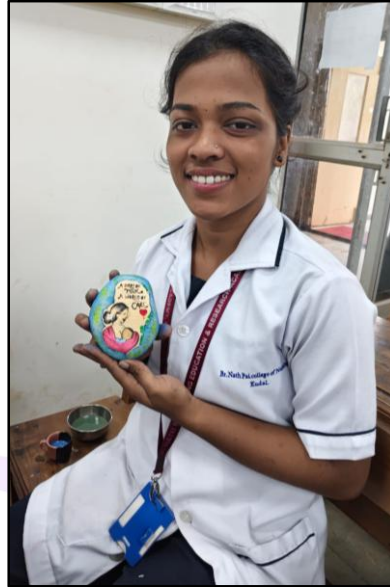

Objectives

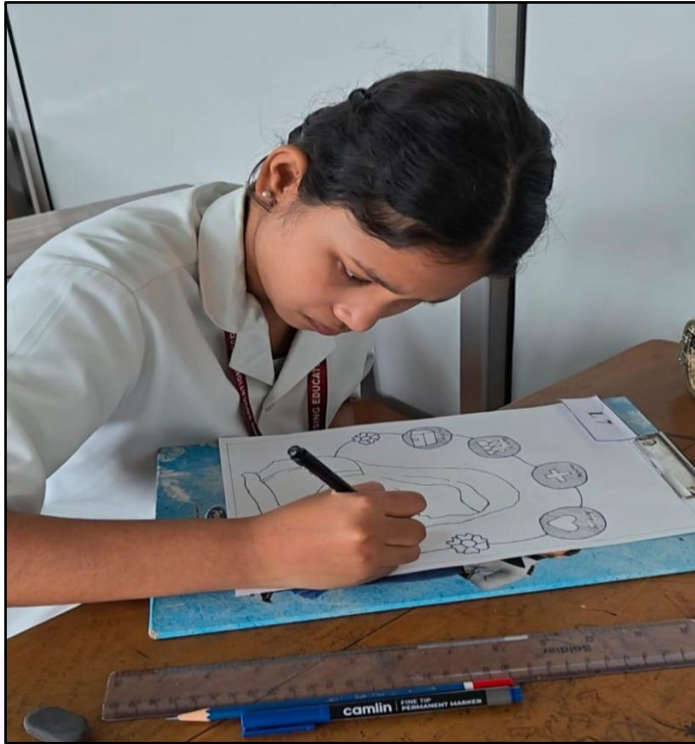
- To create awareness about the importance of breastfeeding.

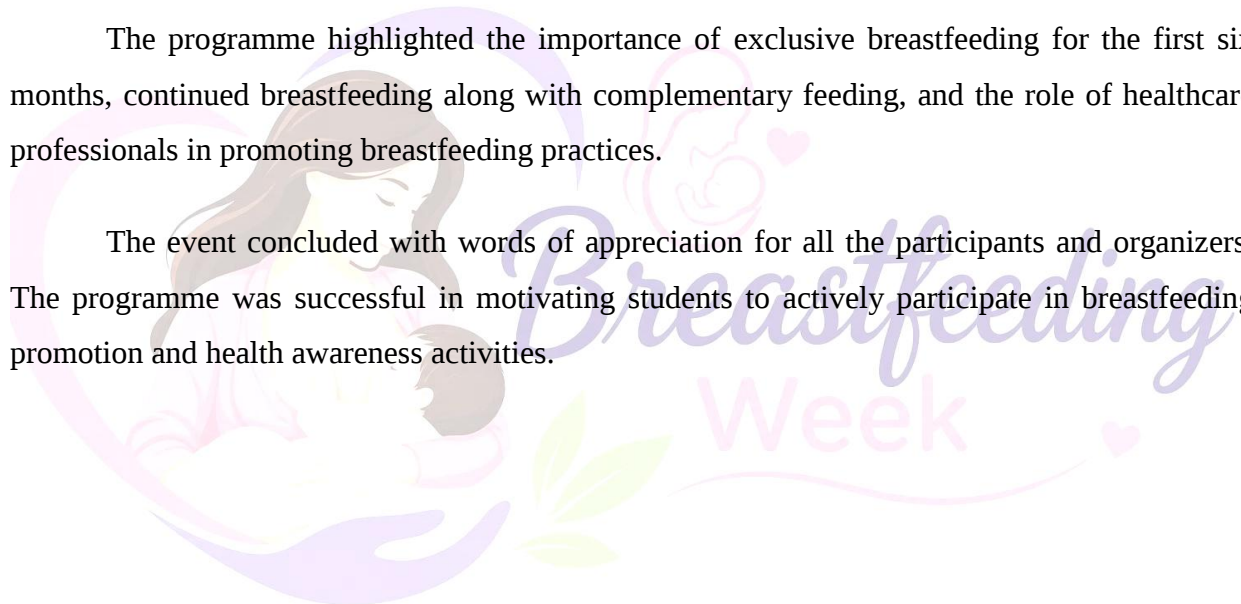
Prize Distribution
